Operations Report September 2008:

- Adoptions: At the PetSmart Adoptathon weekend on September 13th, we adopted out 6 animals. Also, we had several comments about how well our dogs behaved at the store. Cat adoptions have increased over the past six weeks, most likely due to the fact that we have an abundance of kittens available for adoption. We have had quite a few families find kittens to adopt through our website.
- Melvin, Billy, Koda and Maddie, dogs that participated in the 4-H Shelter Dog Training Partnership, have been adopted. The families that adopted Melvin and Maddie heard about the dogs through the program or saw them at the Iowa County Fair.
- Over the last two months, several of our ICHS adoptable animals from our Channel 3 and Channel 15 RV spots have been adopted. Alisha had highlighted Blazer, Maddie and Hank on Channel 15. All three dogs have been adopted. Both Hank and Blazer's new families had seen the dogs on TV. From Channel 3 spots, Mugsy, Billy and Mufasa have been adopted.
- Before the reunion was cancelled, the shelter staff did a great job of preparing the shelter for the event. Many staff members did extra cleaning without being asked.
- I was able to have two special dog surgeries done through Shelter from the Storm. One dog needed a lump removed from her back. The other dog needed to be spayed and needed an eye removed because of a previous injury. Both dogs have gone to their new homes.
- I contacted other shelters about their business hours and am waiting for feedback from their staff. Dane, Green, Jefferson and Sauk County Humane Societies are all closed at least one day a week. Two of the shelters are closed Sunday, one is closed Wednesday and one shelter is closed Monday and Wednesday.
- After I return from vacation, I will need to assess staffing levels on the weekends to see if I need to hire. We have had two kennel staff leave who worked weekends. One of these staff members is volunteering on the weekends when she is available.
