Operations Report October 2008:

- Adoptions: Cat and dog adoptions have been slow over the past three weeks compared to the number of incoming animals. During the month of October, we missed an adoption day at PetSmart due to lack of volunteer help. I am trying to recruit a volunteer from the Dodgeville area to drive adoptable cats and dogs from the shelter to PetSmart West and back again on our scheduled adoption days. We will be back on our normal schedule of adoption days at PetSmart on the second and fourth Saturday of each month starting this Saturday, 10/25.
- On October 13th, we started having volunteers from the Iowa County Jail come over and help us with cleaning kennels and other tasks. This has helped a lot since we have been short staffed recently due to staff illness and vacations.
- The Lands End Woof Walk has been a wonderful experience for the shelter. As of today, we have had over 65 Lands End employees volunteer to walk a dog!! Several employees come back every day to walk at least two dogs. The Lands End employees are energetic and determined to make this fundraising event a success. Also, we have noticed that our dogs are greeting people in a calmer manner and that the kennels are cleaner in the mornings. Sometimes, we will have as many as twelve volunteers walking dogs.
- Over the last couple of weeks, we have been overwhelmed with the number of people calling to rehome their animals, especially cats. I am trying to redirect people to call breed rescues, other shelters or give them advice on finding their animal a home. Most people who call are moving or have animals that are aggressive.
