Operations Report:

- We were not at PetSmart in April because of scheduling conflicts with volunteers. Our next Saturday at PetSmart will be May 2nd. PetSmart is having a national adopt-a-thon that weekend. We will be back to our every other Saturday schedule.
- Adoptions this month have been slow. Potential adopters are waiting for puppies and kittens. Also, half of our animals at the shelter currently have challenging adoption placement needs.
- “Kitten season” has started. We have several litters of tiny kittens at the shelter, but they are too young for adoption.
- We have had two Girl Scout troops come to the shelter for visits this month.
- Transferred 2 more cats to Angel’s Wish Rescue in April. One cat had been at the shelter for three years. The four cats Angel’s Wish took in March were adopted.
- Transferred 6 cats to Dane County Humane Society’s Mounds Satellite adoption centers. Two of the cats have been adopted.
- Boyd, a Catahoula Leopard dog mix, had the cause of his heart murmur diagnosed by a specialist, Dr. Bortnowski. Dr. Bortnowski donated her services. (Boyd has heart disease.)
