Operations Report:

- PetSmart adoptions: We adopted 2 dogs and 1 cat earlier this month at PetSmart.
- I have started to setup our new animal management software. The setup and training will take about a month to complete. The new program will streamline paperwork, update adoptable animals to our website automatically and generate various statistical reports.
- We are receiving an overwhelming amount of requests from pet owners wanting to surrender their cats or dogs to the shelter for various reasons. The most common reason for people wanting to rehome their animals is that people are moving and don't want to or can't take their animals with them. Since the shelter is currently at capacity, the staff gives people information for other rescue organizations and ideas for people to find their animals homes themselves.
