Operations Report:

- PetSmart adoptions: We adopted 1 cat and 1 dog this month. Next PetSmart adoption day is Saturday, June 5th.
- We have now switched to PetPoint software to track shelter animals. All current shelter and foster animals are entered into the new program. We are not entering anymore animal information into the old database but still have access to some of the information that has not been corrupted.
- In June, we will start microchipping animals adopted from the shelter.
- Kitten season has arrived. We have twenty kittens under 8 weeks old either in foster care or at the shelter waiting to go to foster care.
- We are still receiving an overwhelming amount of requests from pet owners wanting to surrender their cats or dogs to the shelter for various reasons. Most requests this month are from Lafayette and Grant counties.
- The 4-H Dog Project has started for the summer. Several shelter dogs are participating with their 4-H trainers. Some dogs will be going to foster with their trainers.
