Outreach Updates:

- Final vaccination/licensing clinic numbers = 49 animals total participated with 18 new licenses
- United Fund grant money of \$1000 is coming for the Pets of Abuse Victims Sheltering Program. We have received much favorable response and interest in this program including people interested in becoming foster homes for the program.
- We are assisting the Sheriff's Department in reviewing their Domestic Abuse Policy and Procedure to include pets involved in these situations. This will provide guidance for deputies and serve as a reminder that animals are an important part of domestic violence situations.
- In addition, we discussed with the Sheriff's Department the possibility of pets being included in any protective orders issued as a part of domestic violence cases. The DA's office is on board and supportive of this and pets should now be able to be included in bond conditions issued by the court which will provide additional protection not just to the human victims but also to the animal victims, as well.
- We will be presenting the animal safety program at the Rural Youth Safety Fair for the second year in a row on May 11th.
- A new brochure has been developed providing information on being a responsible animal owner in Iowa County. The brochure provides concise, basic information on the Animal Regulations and Treatment ordinances. Brochures are under development to provide concise information for Commercial Animal Establishment and Exotic Animal permits, as well.
